Why an HRT patch versus a pill?

• **Low Therapeutic Doses**

The levels of hormone entering the body from ProHRT are low and are similar to levels achieved in a phase of your menstrual cycle. That's true in part because the hormone in ProHRT passes directly through the skin and into the bloodstream, avoiding the digestive tract and liver metabolism.

• **Controlled, Sustained Release... ONLY FROM ProHRT!**

Wearing the ProHRT patch over the 7-day wear period provides effective relief of your moderate to severe menopausal symptoms and may help to prevent postmenopausal osteoporosis.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING PROHRT:

Hormone replacements increase the chances of getting cancer of the uterus (womb). Report any unusual bleeding right away while you are taking hormone replacements. Do not use hormone replacements with or without progestins to prevent heart disease, heart attacks or strokes. Using hormone replacements with or without progestins may increase your chances of getting heart attacks, strokes, breast cancer and blood clots. Using hormone replacements may increase your risk of dementia (decline in memory and thinking skills). The most common side effects that may occur with ProHRT are headache, breast tenderness, and back pain.

ProHRT should not be used if you have unusual bleeding; currently have or have had certain cancers, including cancer of the breast or uterus; had a stroke or heart attack in the recent past (for example, in the past year); currently have or have had blood clots; currently have or have had liver problems; or think you may be, or know that you are, pregnant.
